We offer **exhibition private views by appointment** for people unable to visit during standard opening hours, including mask-wearing and other precautions.

## On site



Exhibitions include Audio, Braille, Easier Read and Dyslexia-friendly interpretations.



Level access is throughout and two-metre wide corridors, allowing two wheelchair, mobility aid or pushchair users, and people with Guide and Support dogs, to pass comfortably.



Inclusive toilets of varying sizes, including one with a shower. Two disabled parking bays are available, and can be reserved.



Sensory ear defenders and induction loops.



Depending on the nature of each exhibition, we can offer Quiet Hours.
