## Colouring sheets- The Art House tiles

### What you'll need

- Floral patterned colouring sheets
- Pencil
- Colouring pens/pencils

These designs are from the tiles on the walls in the old library part of The Art House building. They are in a beautiful combination of dark blue, light blue, and bright green - we thought you might like to try creating your own versions by colouring in these sheets. We've included a few copies so that you can experiment with different colour combination, here are some ideas:

**01.** Blues and greens like the original tiles.

**02.** Your favourite colours.

**03.** Warm colours - pick from reds, oranges, yellows and pinks.

**04.** Try one of these colour pairs: Red and green, Blue and orange, yellow and purple.

On sheet (5) we've taken three of the shapes out of the tile design and put them at the bottom of the page. Complete the design:

**05.** Try drawing the shapes we've removed back into the design. Think about which way up they go and which shape goes where.

**06.** Draw three of your own shapes and add them to the spaces in the design.
