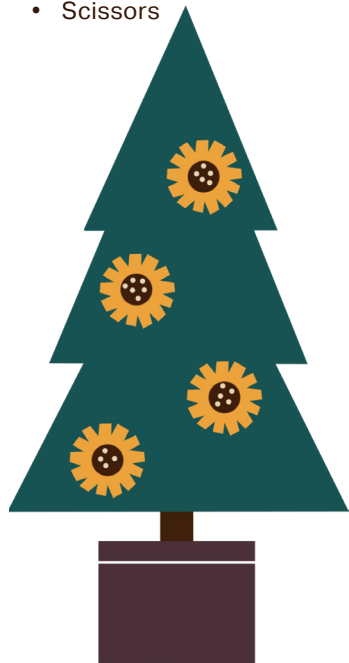


# A Gift From The Art House

## Tinsel the Terrier

### What you'll need

- Colouring pens/pencils
- Tinsel the Terrier card
- Gluestick
- Printed card
- Scissors



We've designed this cute festive Yorkshire Terrier for you to make, complete with antlers and Christmas jumper!

**01.** Colour in your Terrier however you like – use pencils, pens or even paint. You could even add some Christmas sparkle!

**02.** Cut around the outline of each section with a pair of scissors. Be careful and take your time.

**03.** Fold along the lines marked with a white arrow. You can then start to form the shape of your toy. Make sure all of the illustrated sections on the head and body are on the outside of the 3D shape.

**04.** Glue the areas marked with a '+'.

**05.** Stick the tabs to the inside surfaces to form the head and the body. The triangular sections on top of the head should be glued back-to-back. You can then glue the antlers to the back of this section with the illustrated side facing the front. Attach the head to the top of the body and glue the tail on at the bottom...

Then step back and admire Tinsel in all her glory!
