# CIRCULAR ROUTE

## KEY

### Start your journey at The Art House

Head to Wakefield's first Cycle Station at The Art House to get your bike in top condition for the day ahead! Grab a refreshing drink to-go at the coffee house or have a peek at the latest exhibition before you get underway.

### Next stop, Thornes Park

From Westgate to Thornes Park is all on the path, remember to share safely with pedestrians and use the cycle crossings. If the weather's nice you can take a break and enjoy a picnic in the sun. There's lots to see!

### Onward to The Hepworth Wakefield

From Avondale Road to The Hepworth Wakefield you're cycling on the road, make sure to obey traffic lights and road signs. The Hepworth Garden is a beautiful public green space and the perfect stop for a breather. The gallery, shop and café are well worth a visit.

### Circling back to the centre

From here to the main shopping precinct you're on the path, follow the signs and cross the roundabout safely. There's a bike rack at the bottom of Kirkgate so you can stop to look around the Cathedral, open-air stalls on market days, or independent bars and restaurants.

### Some history to finish

Back on the road to cycle past the Cathedral and onto Northgate. There is a bike rack outside the County Hall which is a perfect place to stop and visit Wakefield Museum and Library at Wakefield One.

Head back to The Art House for a well-deserved sit down.
