This is their exhibition. It is called **Conversations with Nature.**

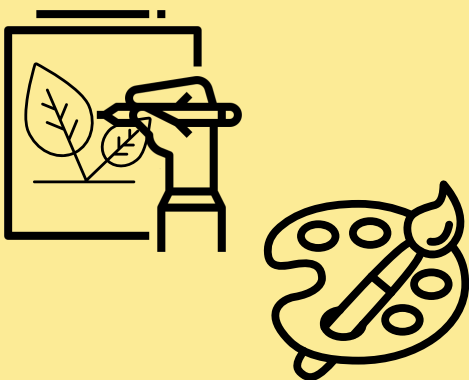
The Art House

Helen is interested in painting wild plants that we sometimes do not notice. These plants can grow in unusual places.

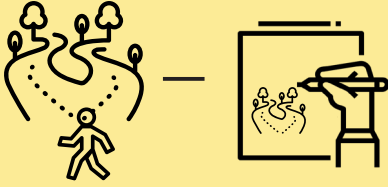


Some people think of them as weeds, like dandelions, but Helen sees the beauty in them.

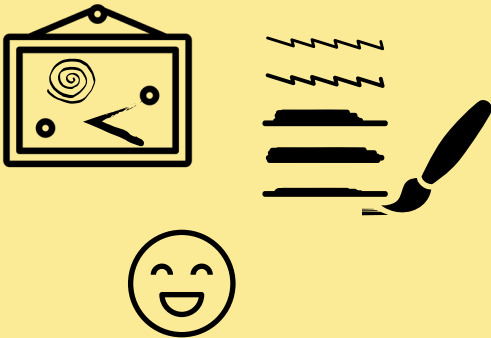


About Alison

Alison lives in Cumbria, England. She has a studio near the coast.

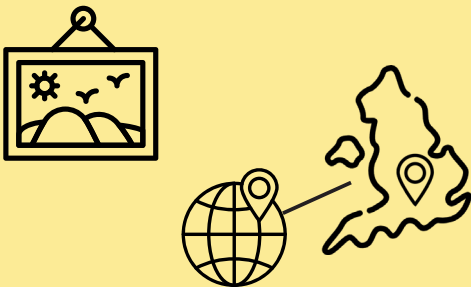


Alison likes to paint from memory after spending time in nature.
