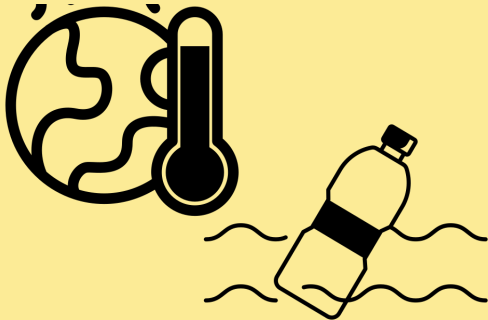


This exhibition is called **Perspectives** It is by the artist Jessie Davies.

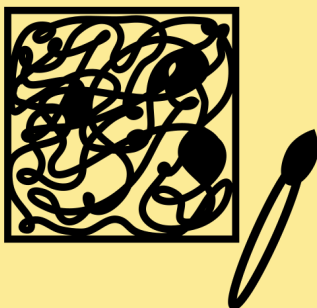
Jessie likes to paint. She uses her art to highlight that wetlands are important for our planet.



Wetlands are areas where water covers the ground, like ponds, rivers and reedbeds. But weather, rising temperature and pollution are threatening these.



Jessie is disabled and uses a wheelchair. She sits amongst the reeds where she paints. She notices the rubbish left behind.



Jessie uses some of the reeds in her paintings. They are colourful and have lots of texture.



Jessie stayed at The Art House and made new artwork. It was the first time she was able to use a pottery wheel and printing processes.

Some of Jessie's ceramic pots and prints are on display alongside new paintings.
