













This exhibition is called **A Glimmer**. It is by the artist Bijan Amini-Alavijeh.

Bijan made new art using materials like paper, card, and foil to create sculptures. He uses lights to cast shadows.

His work mixes different shapes and ideas to make us think about beauty and patterns that we might see everyday in nature.

Bijan's art is inspired by patterns and designs from Medieval England and Persian art and design. Persian refers to things from the country now called Iran, in the Middle East.

He especially loves using circles, which he thinks are very special because they stand for unity and perfection.

His artworks are made using lots of repeating shapes. You will see that they might look different with the changing light and shadows. This makes the space feel calm.

Bijan works in Wakefield, which is a great place to learn about sculpture. His new work explores what modern sculpture can be like today.
