

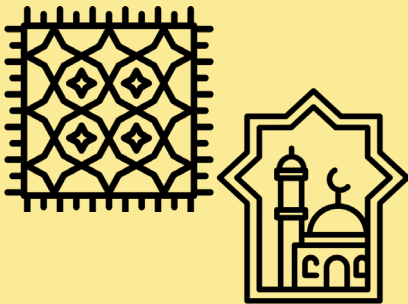


This exhibition is called **Paradise Carpet**. It is by the artist Zarah Hussain.

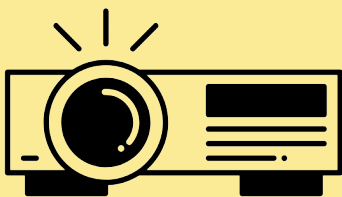
It features a colorful carpet made of light projections and shapes that changes as you watch it.
